- ▶ cleaner oil and filters can allow for increasing the time between oil changes, potentially saving you even more money
- ▶ states are beginning to look at mandates for the amount of biodiesel that must be blended into all diesel sold in the state, with MN having already implemented B2 statewide; Governor Bredesen has begun considering the same in TN

In the workshop, there will be presentations from:

- ▶ A major regional biodiesel producer who will discuss their biodiesel production process and their product and its benefits to your diesel vehicles

- ▶ A representative from the local Clean Cities coalition who will be there to answer questions about biodiesel use in and around Tennessee
