It is important for you to begin learning about biodiesel for a couple of reasons:

- biodiesel can help your diesel vehicles' engines last longer, saving you money
- fuel economy gains can more than offset any incremental cost you might pay, further saving you money
- cleaner oil and filters can allow for increasing the time between oil changes, potentially saving you even more money
- states are beginning to look at mandates for the amount of biodiesel that must be blended into all diesel sold in the state, with MN having already implemented B2 statewide; Governor Bredesen has already begun considering the same in TN

In the workshop, there will be presentations from:

- A representative from the local Clean Cities coalition who will be there to answer questions about biodiesel's use in and around Tennessee
- A major regional biodiesel producer who will discuss their production and the benefits of their product to your diesel vehicles
- An additive supplier who will detail important information that is needed when moving to a biodiesel blend, including appropriate winterization
- Eastman who will talk about their experience thus far with B5 and B20; they have been using B20 since April 1 this year
